(v) Resolution 137(XII) on technical co-operation activities and technical assistance projects

1. With reference to resolution 137(xii), the following is pertinent to the advisory services and technical co-operation projects foreseen for 1986-1987.

I. REGIONAL ADVISORY SERVICES

2. The secretariat of the Commission, in compliance with the said resolution, established contact with members of the Commission through official channels and mounted missions to identify the priority needs of member countries for advisory services. The secretariat of the Commission also established contact with United Nations Headquarters to explore the possibility of increasing the number of regional advisory posts available to the secretariat. In view of the limited resources for advisory services and the financial constraints facing the United Nations, it was not possible to increase the number of posts. However, the secretariat of the Commission will continue its contact with organizations of the United Nations system as well as with regional and bilateral donors with the aim of increasing its advisory services to member countries.

3. In view of the above, the following short-term advisory services will be provided in 1986:

(a) Eight regional advisers financed under section 24 of the regular budget in:

- (i) Human resources development;
- (ii) Development planning;
- (iii) Informatics and microelectronics development;
- (iv) National accounts and economic statistics;
- (v) Industrial project identification, formulation and appraisal;
- (vi) Transport and communications;
- (vii) New and renewable sources of energy;
- (viii) Sampling and household survey design.

(b) Two regional advisers financed by the United Nations Fund for Population Activities (UNFPA) in the following areas:

- (i) Demographic studies and analysis;
- (ii) Population statistics and censuses.

(c) One regional adviser financed by the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) in industrialization and mechanical engineering;

(d) Two regional advisers within the context of the household survey project financed by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in:

(i) Data processing;

(ii) Household survey training and execution.

4. Additionally, and depending on the resources that will become available in 1987, the secretariat of the Commission endeavours to provide advisory services in agriculture, science and technology, human settlements and environment.

II. PROJECTS

5. ESCWA, as executing agency, will execute projects mainly financed by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), UNFPA and the United Nations Development Fund for Women (UNIFEM). As the process of project identification, formulation, approval and budgeting is a continually evolving one, and as the priority areas for UNDP's programming cycle are yet to be determined, it is not possible to list all projects that will be financed from extrabudgetary resources. However, the following indications may be listed for 1986-1987:
