Note by the Executive Secretary

- 1. In accordance with General Assembly resolution 3043 (27) of 19 December 1972, the regular budget of the Economic Commission for Western Asia is prepared and approved on a biennium basis.
- 2. For the biennium 1984-1985, the revised approved allotments for Section 14 amounted to US\$ 26,929,800.

I. ALLOCATION OF RESOURCES

A. The allocation of resources for the biennium 1984-1985

3. For the biennium from 1 January 1984 to 31 December 1985, the General Assembly approved a total of 116 Professional and 211 General Service posts.
