How to get to ESCWA

General

The thirteenth session of the Economic and Social Commission for Western asia will be held in Baghdad, Iraq, from 19-24 April 1986.

The Technical Committee will hold its fourth session on the Programme of Work and Priorities 1986-1987 in the Committee Room of the Conference Building from 19-22 April.

The official inaugural session of the Commission at the ministerial level will be convened at 10 a.m. on 23 April for two days.

Reception on arrival

Provided that advance notice is given, participants will be met on arrival at Saddam International Airport and will be assisted with customs formalities. Hotels will provide complimentary transport service from the airport for their guests.

Expected date and time of arrival in Baghdad and flight number should be sent to ESCWA by cable or telex. The cable address is UN-ESCWA BAGHDAD, Telex 213303 or 213389 IK,. ESCWA should be notified as soon as possible of any change in a participant's arrival plans.

The above information should be supplied in addition to official notification by Governments and organizations, etc. to the Executive Secretary of ESCWA, Baghdad, concerning the membership of delegations.

Participants are advised to attach "ESCWA BAGHDAD" labels to thier baggage and to wear identity badges for easy identification in order to avoid any inconveniences to them such as possible delay at the airport on arrival. The labels and identity badges will be provided to participants together with this circular.

Regulations for visitors

Health certificates

The following health certificates are required from foreigners visiting Iraq:

Cholera: For arrivals from epidemic areas, with the exception of children under 12 months, a vaccination certificate valid six days after the first vaccination and for six months after the second.

Yellow fever: For arrivals from epidemic or previously epidemic areas: a vaccination certificate valid 10 days after vaccination for 10 years.

Smallpox: For arrivals from epidemic or previously epidemic areas, with the exception of children under 12 months: a vaccination certificate valid eight days after the first successful vaccination for three years.

Customs

A tourist may have the following admitted duty-free: 200 cigarettes, 50 cigars, 250 gms. of tobacco, 1 litre of wine or alcoholic beverage, 1 litre of perfume. Also: one camera, one radio, one recorder, with the provision that he shall take them out with him/her on departure.

Where to stay

First Class Hotels

What to wear

Iraq's climate varies in accordance with the four seasons.

<u>Winter</u>: In December, January and February, it tends to be cold. Temperatures may sometimes drop to below 0°C. Warm woolen clothes are then necessary. Overcoats or raincoats may be advisable.

Spring: In March, April and May, the climate is temperate. Light woolen or cotton clothes are worn. A raincoat may sometimes be necessary.

<u>Summer</u>: In June, July and August, light cotton clothes are advisable.

<u>Autumn</u>: In September, October and November, clothes similar to those worn in spring are advisable.

Transportation

ESCWA will not be able to provide transportation facilities during the conference. Participants may wish to make their own arrangements for getting to and from meetings and other social functions.

The Rasheed Hotel, Mansour Melia Hotel and Al-Sadeer Novotel will arrange transportation for their guests twice a day for the duration of the meeting. Guests may check with the hotels for schedule.

Identification

Summer time begins in Iraq on 1 April by advancing the clock by one hour at midnight, and ends on 30 September when the clock is put back by one hour at midnight.

Office hours during the month of Ramadan begin one hour later in all Government departments and establishments, except for those whose work requirements demand otherwise.

Shopping

Most shops are open daily from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. They generally close on Fridays.

A large variety of souvenirs can be found in the souks and bazaars located just off Rashid Street, between Martyrs (Shuhada) Bridge and Ahrar Bridge. One of the most interesting is the Souk Al Safafir (Coppersmiths' market). In addition, the Folklore Centre near Karrada Junction displays handicrafts from all parts of the country.

Credentials

It is requested that participants bring with them their official credentials duly signed by the appropriate authorities of their respective Governments, agencies or organizations, which will be handed to the Secretary of the Commission or the Conference Officer at the time of registration.

Documents
