General

The fourteenth session of the Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia, to be held at the ministerial level, will convene at the Commission's headquarters in Baghdad, Iraq, on 4 and 5 April 1987. The formal inaugural session will begin at 10 a.m. on 4 April.

The ministerial meeting will be preceded by the fifth session of the Commission's Technical Committee, to be held from 31 March to 2 April.

All plenary meetings will be held in the main Conference Hall, located in the Conference Building.

Reception on arrival

Provided that advance notice is given, participants will be met on arrival at Saddam International Airport and will be assisted with Customs formalities. Hotels provide a complimentary transport service to and from the airport for their guests.

How to get to ESCWA

The headquarters of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia is in the Amiriyah Quarter, on the Airport Road. To reach the ESCWA premises from the airport, drive past the Abbas ibn Firnas monument and take the next exit, just before the overpass. To reach ESCWA from the city centre, take the Airport Road and make a U-turn just as you arrive at the Abbas ibn Firnas monument. Then, as above, take the next exit, just before the overpass. Turn right again immediately, onto the road running parallel to the Airport Road. ESCWA headquarters is straight ahead on the left.

Participants should communicate the expected date and time of their arrival and their flight number to ESCWA by

cable or telex. The cable address is UN--ESCWA BAGHDAD, and the telex numbers 213303 or 213389 IK. ESCWA should be notified as soon as possible of any change of plans.

The above information should be supplied in addition to the official notification by governments and organizations to the Executive Secretary of ESCWA concerning the membership of delegations.

Please be advised that Iraqi Airways does not permit passengers to carry hand-baggage with them on board the aircraft.

Participants are advised to attach labels marked "ESCWA BAGHDAD" to their baggage and to wear identity badges for easy identification on arrival. This will enable them to avoid any inconvenience, such as possible delay at the airport. The labels and identity badges will be provided to participants together with this booklet.

Regulations for visitors

Health certificates

Only yellow-fever health certificates are required from foreigners visiting Iraq from epidemic or previously epidemic areas: a vaccination certificate is valid from 10 days after vaccination for a period of 10 years.

Customs

The duty-free allowances are as follows: 200 cigarettes, or 50 cigars, or 250 grams of tobacco; 1 litre of wine or spirits; 1 litre of perfume. Each visitor may also bring into the country one camera, one radio and one cassette recorder, provided that they are re-exported on departure.

Where to stay

Arrangements have been made with Al-Rasheed Hotel (an Oberoi hotel, Haifa Str., Tel: 7766127) for the accommodation of participants. The hotel and ESCWA will also provide transport to and from ESCWA and social functions. The rates per night (including continental breakfast) are as follows:

Single room: ID 27.000	Junior suite: ID 55.000
Double room: ID 33,000	Presidential suite: ID 110.000

A service charge of 10 per cent is payable on all bills.

Lunch or dinner on a fixed menu (two choices) costs ID 6.000, and a la carte meals are available at between ID 3.500 and ID 5.000. There is a 24-hour room service and free entrance to the swimming pool, tennis courts and bowling alley. The hotel also provides an airport pick-up service and a shuttle coach service from the hotel to various important points in the city.

There are other first-class hotels in the city. However, for the convenience of participants (especially as regards transport), the above package is recommended.

Identification

Telex

ESCWA will handle delegations' telexes as far as possible, against payment of the official rate. Hotels charge 20 per cent in addition to the official tariff for telex communications.

Iraqi Summer Time begins at midnight on 1 April, when clocks are advanced one hour, and ends at midnight on 30 September, when clocks are put back one hour.

Shopping

Most shops are open daily from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. They generally close on Fridays.

A large variety of souvenirs can be found in the souks and bazaars located just off Rashid Street, between Shuhada Bridge and Ahrar Bridge. One of the most interesting is the Souk al-Safafir (coppersmiths' market). In addition, the Folklore Centre near the Karradah Circle displays handicrafts from all parts of the country.

Credentials

Official credentials duly signed by the competent authorities of governments, agencies or organizations should be handed to the Secretary of the Commission or to the Conference Officer at the time of registration.

Documents

During the session, documents will be available at the documents distribution desk in the Conference Building. Participants are, however, earnestly requested to bring with them the complete sets of documents sent to their governments or organizations since supplies will be limited.

Participants wishing to submit documents for circulation should present them to the Secretary of the Commission or the Conference Officer. In accordance with United Nations regulations for the control and limitation of documentation, the secretariat cannot undertake to translate or reproduce documents or statements submitted by individual delegations unless the Commission takes a specific a decision to that effect and approves the financial implications thereof. Participants are advised to consult the Secretary of the Commission on any matter pertaining to the issuance or distribution of documents at the session.

ESCWA Library

The Library is located on the ground floor of the Secretariat Building. Library services are available to ESCWA staff and to representatives of member States and international organizations.

The Library collections include: books, periodicals, newspapers, reports and microfilms; documents of the United Nations, the specialized agencies, Arab governments and regional organizations in the economic, social and technical fields; reference material on economics, sociology, transport, planning, statistics, natural resources, science and technology; and basic reference material.

The Library publishes: cumulative lists of ESCWA documents; a list of available periodicals; bibliographies; contents of recent periodicals received; and acquisition lists.

The Library is open from 7.30 a.m. to 2.30 p.m. Books and documents can be borrowed by ESCWA staff; all other users may consult the collection while in the Library. There is a limited photocopying service for outside users.
