145 (XIII) Economic and social conditions of the Palestinian Arab people under occupation

The Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia,

Recalling its resolution 30(III) of 14 May 1976 in which it appealed to the Economic and Social Council for prompt action to take practical measures to ensure the improvement of the economic and social conditions of the Palestinian Arab people in their homeland, its resolution 108(IX) of 11 May 1982 on assistance to the Palestine Liberation Organization, and its resolution 132(XI) of 26 April 1984 calling for special attention to be devoted to social and economic studies on the Palestinian people in the occupied territories,

Further recalling its resolution 139(XII) of 24 April 1985 in which it called upon the Executive Secretary to ensure that all available data and information relating to the occupied Palestinian territories are included in all studies and statistical abstracts issued by the Commission at the regional level and to include in the programme of work and priorities for the period 1986-1987 studies, in co-operation with the concerned Arab and international organizations, on economic and social conditions in the occupied Palestinian territories,
