 - It presents the strategic view for business and trade statistics
 - It identifies principal indicators for the following areas:
 - Business demography and entrepreneurship
 - Globalization and digitalization
 - Well-being and sustainability
 - It provides the analytical and policy framework for these indicators together with their methodological sheets
 - The principal indicators will be recommended for compilation in all countries

- Manual on the maturity model for SBRs
- Maturity model toolkit
 - Questionnaire for self-assessment
 - Links between training material and stages of development
 - Interactive website
- Regular Global Assessment on the status of implementation of SBR in countries
- Development of e-learning course on SBRs
 - A foundational level is being developed by SIAP-ADB -UNSD
