Organization of work

Note by the secretariat

- 1. The secretariat of the Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA) has prepared the proposed organization of work for the fifteenth session of the Statistical Committee to facilitate the consideration of agenda items within set time limitations. The present document sets out the proposed organization of work, which the Committee is invited to adopt in its current or amended form.
- 2. The Statistical Committee will hold its opening meeting on the morning of Wednesday, 16 November 2022 at the United Nations House in Beirut. The Committee is scheduled to hold two meetings on each of the two days of the session. It will conclude its proceedings in the afternoon on Thursday, 17 November 2022.
- 3. As part of the proceedings of its fifteenth session, the Statistical Committee will hold a joint session with the ESCWA Committee on Technology for Development on the theme "Data management modernization using new technologies". The session will begin on the afternoon of Tuesday, 15 November 2022, and will continue at 9 a.m. on Wednesday, 16 November 2022. Registration of participants in the fifteenth session of the Statistical Committee will take place before the joint session on Wednesday morning, from 8.30 to 9 a.m.
- 4. The representative of the ESCWA secretariat will present each item in 15 minutes, and the rest of the time will be allocated for discussions. Should the discussion of an item be completed in less than the specified time, participants will move on to the next item.
