Biennium 2010-2011

- Enhanced capacity of MCs to formulate, adopt and implement policies and measures to improve the sustainable management of natural resources, with particular emphasis on fulfilling the MDGs and addressing climate change challenges.
- Strengthening south-south cooperation in the integrated management of natural resources, with a focus on challenges related to water, energy & climate change.

Biennium 2012-2013

- ❖ Enhanced technical, human, and institutional capacities of member countries to develop and implement national, subregional, and regional policies, strategies and action plans for the sustainable management of energy and water resources in line with the Johannesburg Plan of Implementation.
- Enhanced capacity of governments and other public and private stakeholders to incorporate climate change responses into sectoral strategies and plans, and to stimulate financial and technical supports for the inclusion of climate change issues into plans and strategies.
- Strengthened capacity in member countries to develop and apply best practices and plans for improving sustainable agriculture and rural livelihood and increasing the productivity and competitiveness of small and medium-sized enterprises, in support of achieving the MDGs.


