## SDG 16 indicator framework

- UNODC is custodian of 16 SDG indicators under Goals 3, 5, 11, 15, and 16
- produce data for SDG indicators for global monitoring, based on **national data**
- conduct annual data collection (UN Crime Trends Survey)
- develop methodological standards for the production of SDG indicators
- provide technical assistance to countries

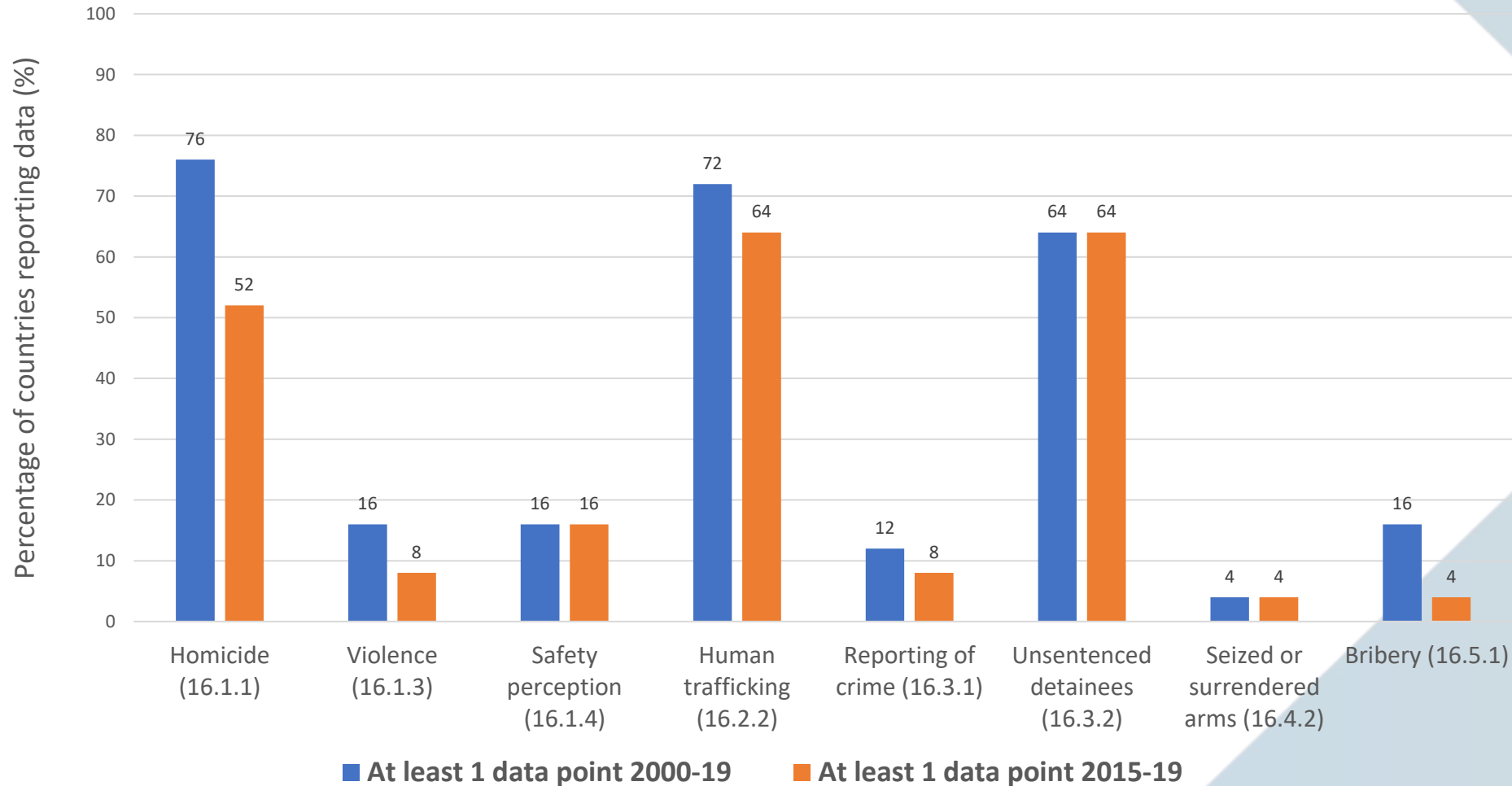

## SDG data availability in the region

Percentage of countries in Western Asia and Northern Africa reporting data on SDG 16 indicators



**Good** data coverage related to dedicated international programs

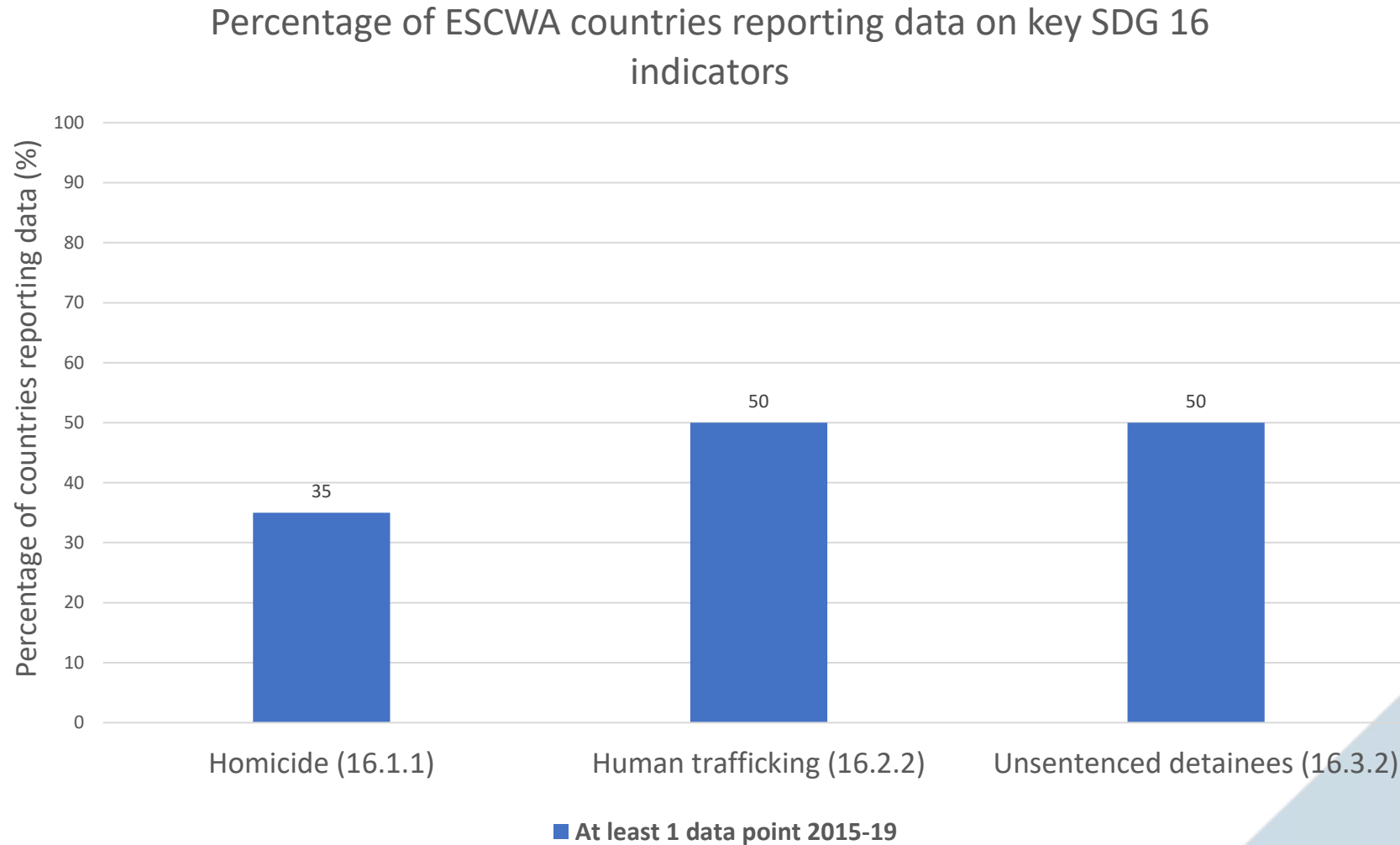
**Poor** data availability due to:

- Data not produced
- Data not shared nationally
- Data not reported at international level

## How to improve SDG data availability in the region?

- **Participate in annual data collection:** UN Crime Trends Survey
  - 2021 questionnaire was sent to national focal points in early June
- **Share existing administrative data** on homicide, prison, trafficking
- **Conduct household/victimisation survey** to produce key indicators on corruption, violence, access to justice
