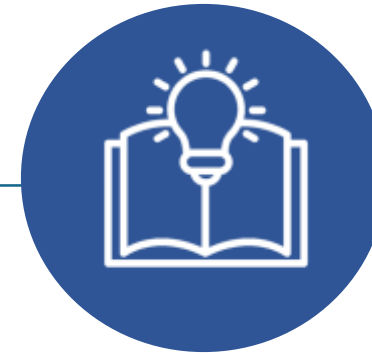

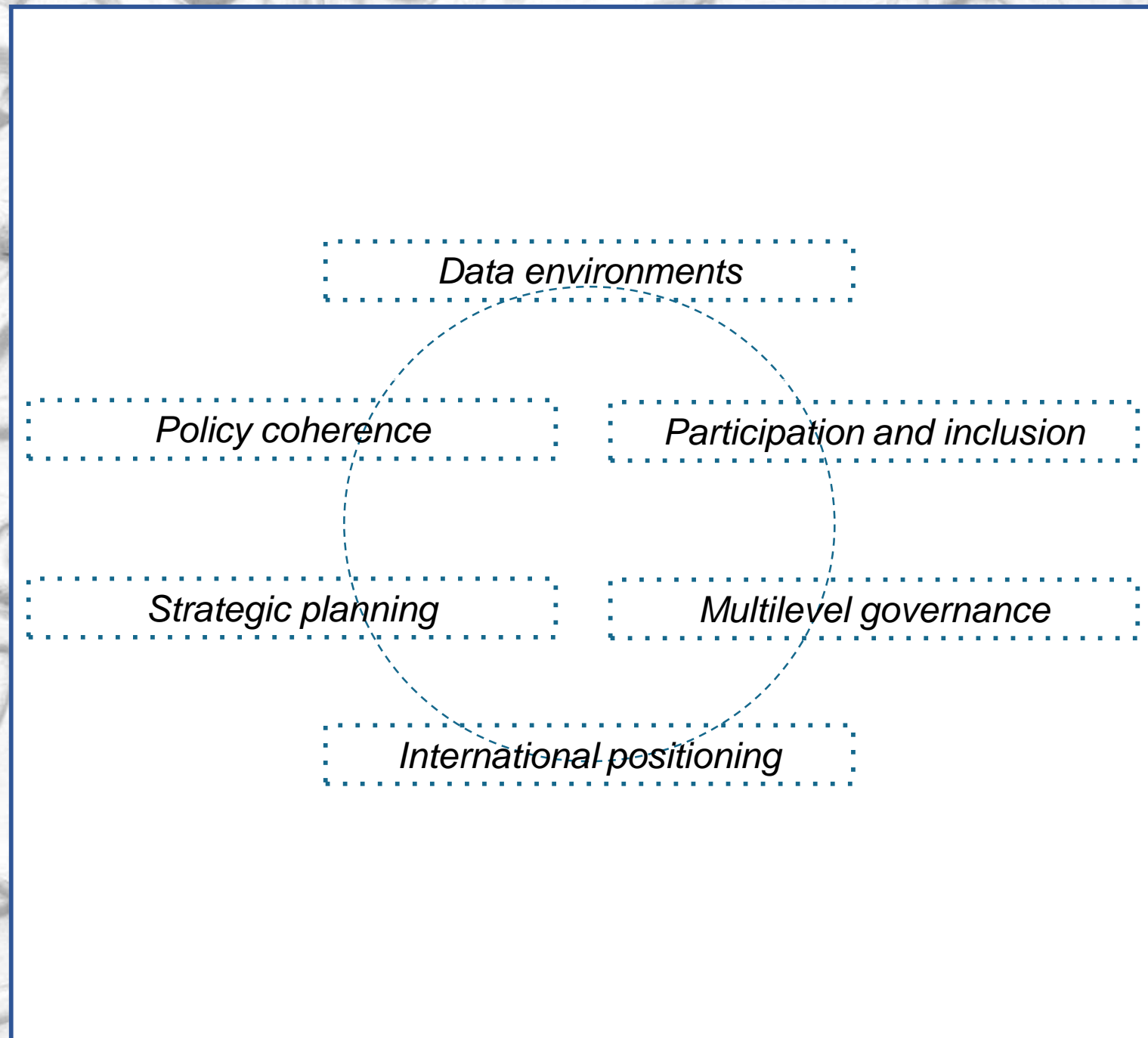
What is a VLR?

No universal definition

Common understanding: VLR aims to assess SDG progress within a given territory with a locally developed narrative.

Potential: strengthening all dimensions of SDG Localization

VLR is increasingly recognized as a powerful process for accelerating the localization of the SDGs



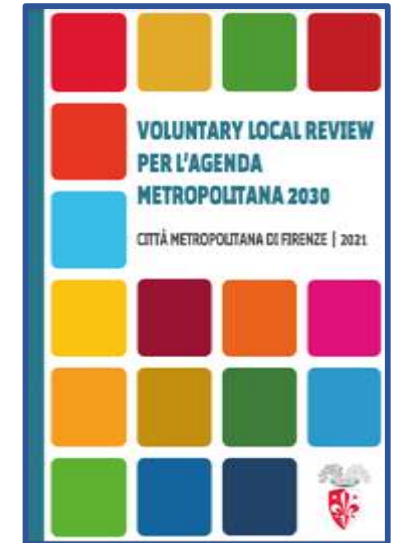
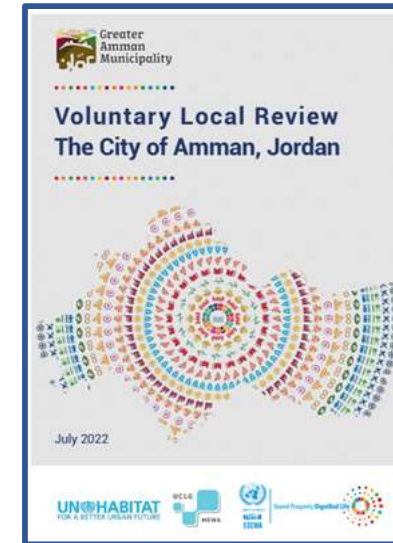
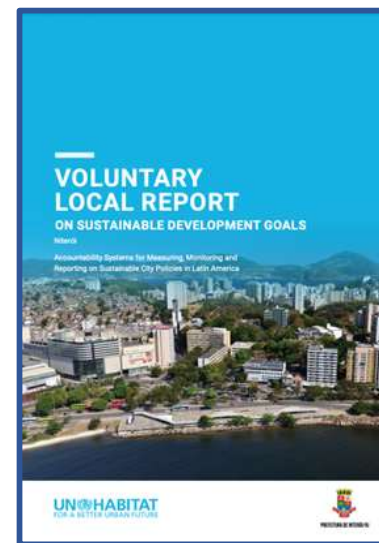

The framework is tailored to a range of scales of cities (tertiary cities to megacities); country classifications (high income to least developed) and to regional specificities.

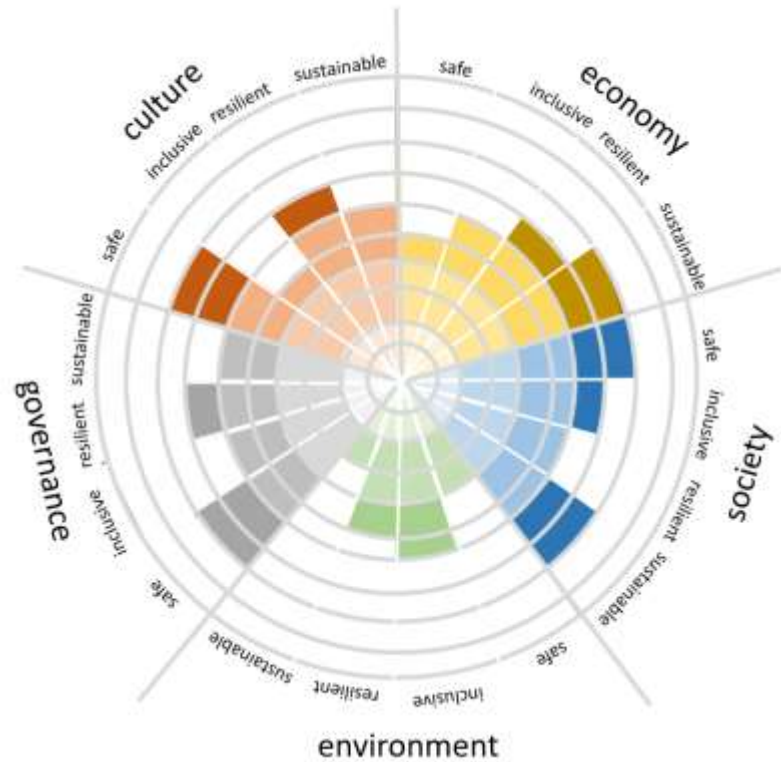

Baseline Assessment

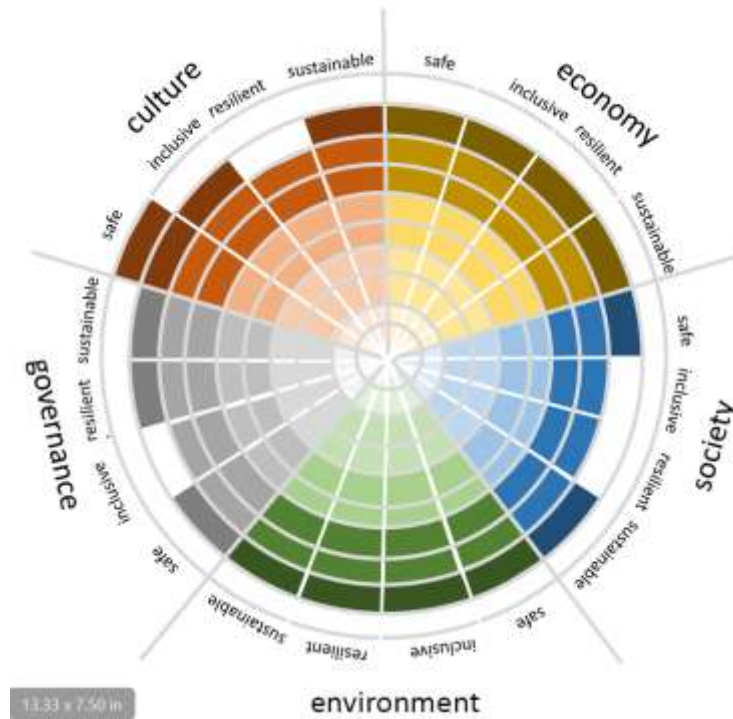
This identifies and spatially maps the status of SDGs, identifying urban areas that are most left behind and priority sectors requiring investment.

Regional Outlook : Jordan, Palestine and Tunisia

Arab States Mayors Academy

The **Academy** will:

- **Engage city mayors/governors** to participate in annual fellowships and build their capacities to develop sustainable urban solutions in their communities.
- Deliver tailored activities through executive training and peer-learning activities, building a **network of local leaders** in the region committed to sustainable urban development.
- **Replicate** SDGs localization efforts of the pilot cities **across the region**.
- **Build on** the successful experience of the Asia-Pacific Mayors' Academy (a comparable process will be developed in the Arab Region)

SDG Localization Platform for the Arab States Region

- This project will support the creation of **regional online platform which would** gather local data in line with the UMF and VLR practices.
- **The main objectives are:**
 - Enhancing transparency
 - Reinforcing data collection at city level
 - Strengthening relations with the national statistics system and the VNR elaboration process
- The platform will seek **synergies** with existing websites and online SDG resources and will be directly linked to the Local 2030 Coalition's platform.



VLR Technical Assistance & VLR-VNR Studios

- Provide technical assistance to local authorities for the development of the VLRs of their respective cities based on the VLR methodology for the Arab region
- Organize studios that act as forums to discuss practices and challenges in connecting local and national reporting for the SDGs, strengthening multilevel articulation and the development of VNRs based on the VLR Regional Methodology



Global and Regional Advocacy



- The project builds on a robust outreach and advocacy component. Project partners and results will be brought to the main intergovernmental and UN-led regional and international processes
- The AFSD is the primary regional mechanism for the Governments and stakeholders to follow up and review the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development
- It creates a roadmap of regional engagement towards HLPF, WUF12 and others

Sustainability of the Regional Track of the Project

The activities of the project are aimed at:

- **Setting the scene to kick start and accelerate SDG localization** in the pilot cities and more broadly at country level, while contributing to the regional efforts to achieve the Global Goals.
- **Mobilizing additional resources** through the SDG Cities flagship programme and others by attracting donors and innovative private public partnerships.
- The **Mayors' Academy process** will also act as catalyser of partnerships and mobilization of cities towards the SDG localization, beyond the pilot cities of the project.
- Such effort will also be backed by the **Local 2030 Coalition**, mobilizing funds and partners to support the follow up and expansion of the project scope and activities, specifically looking at applying the SDG cities localization cycle.

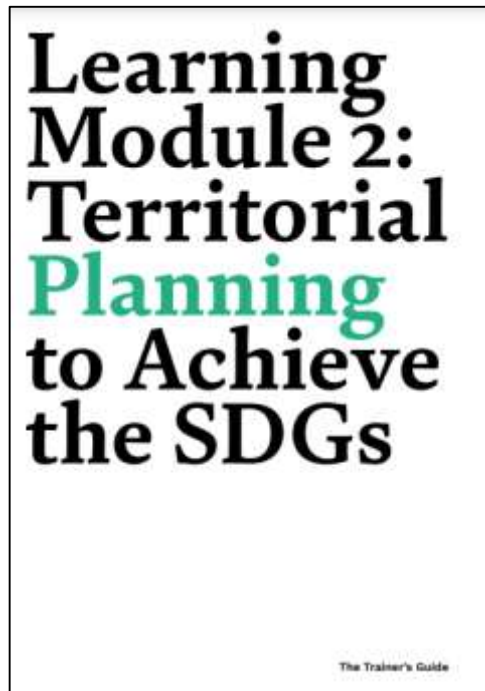
