



#### **FOCALIZING SDGS**



- All development initiatives to have an SDG component.
- Municipal services to be showcased in the SDG platforms.
- Better recognition of municipalities as the main drivers of sustainable development.
- Contributing to the global campaign to consolidate our powers to feed into the 2030 Agenda.







#### **VOCALIZING SDGS**



- Changing the narrative on development and making specific reference to the SDGs
- Local leaders to frame their daily discourse around the SDGs, to raise awareness on the local population
- Sensitizing the public on SDGs through public speeches, conferences, workshops
- Mainstreaming SDGs to create a sense of local ownership.

- Defining SDG indicators at the national and sub-national levels
- Determining local priorities







### UCLG-MEWA Approach

- Highlighting the coherence between the SDGs and the New Urban Agenda
- Both global processes recognize cities as one of the main drivers of sustainable development




# The Pilot Project on Mapping the SDGs in Turkey

2223 Projects evaluated in line with SDGs








The local governments share their SDG progress with the

Although the VLR movement had slowed down in 2020 as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic more than fifty local governments have prepared VLRs since 2017. 10/23






### Challenges for the VLR Process



- Lack of local data & indicators
- Lack of a universal report template
- Lack of awareness among public & municipal staff
- An additional "reporting burden"
- Lack of local/national coordination




#### Advantages for the VLR Process



- Ownership at the mayoral level
- Institutional structuring & coordination mechanism
- Strong cooperation with the local actors
- Collaboration with the national statistical unit
- Participation in the global community


