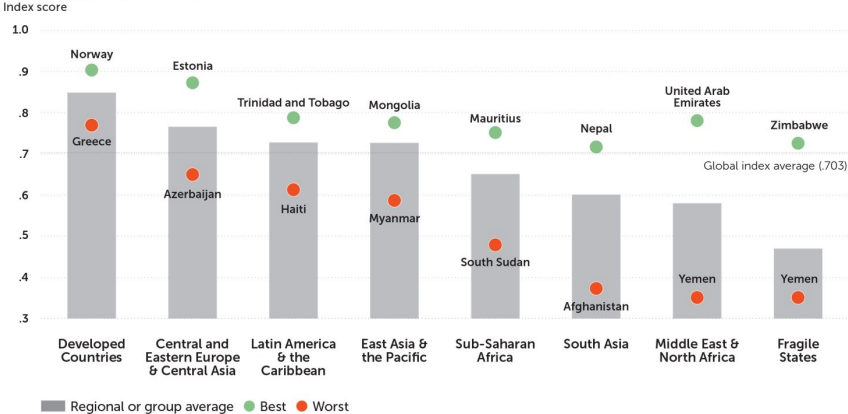

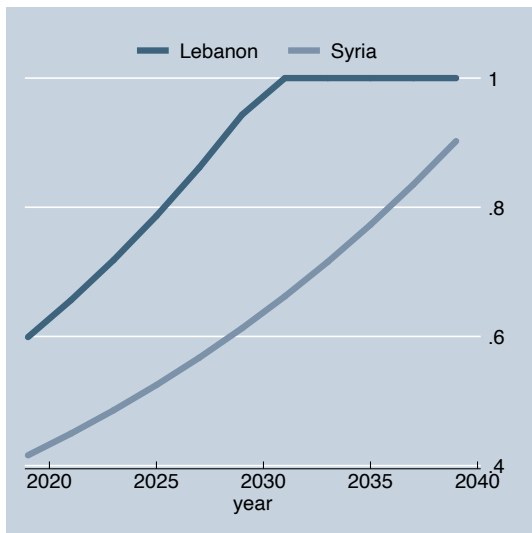

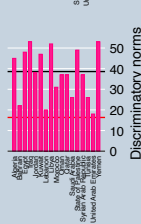
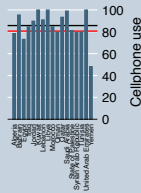
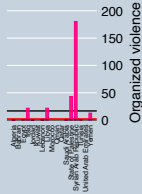
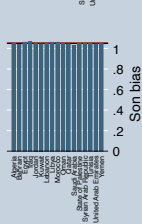
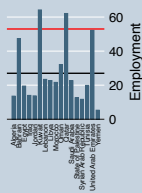
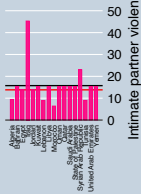
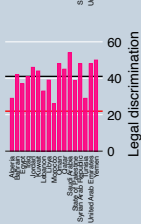
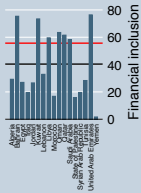
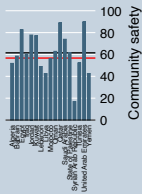
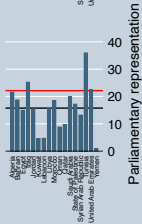
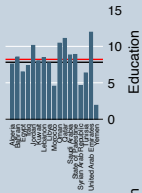
What would the future look like if growth rate continued?

Conclusion

- No MENA countries improve its rank between 2017 and 2019, but 9 countries improves their score.
- Only 3 countries do worse
- The MENA region is the region faring worst on the WPS index, but two countries United Arab Emirates and Bahrain outperform the global average
- It is the region with the biggest discrepancy in scores
- The MENA region does particularly poorly on *Legal Discrimination* and *Discriminatory norms*.
- It outperforms the global average on *Cellphone use* and *Community safety*.
- It is close to the global average on Education, and a few countries do extremely well here.
- if growth continues the same way, Lebanon will outperform Norway in 2039 and Lebanon as early as in 2029.
