#### What is trade facilitation



The primary goal of trade facilitation is to help make trade across borders (imports and exports)

- **▶** Faster
- ► Cheaper
- **▶** Predictable

#### **CUSTOMS**



Customs is an authority or agency in a country responsible for collecting and safeguarding customs duties and for controlling the flow of goods including animals, transports, personal effects and hazardous items in and out of a country.

- ▶ Mainly, Customs does not deal with Persons
- ► Tax and law enforcement
- ► Ministry of Finance? Ministry of Homeland Security? Independent agency? ...
- ▶ but never Ministry of Commerce



### **How FASTER CUSTOMS?**



- 1. Electronic procedures
- 2. Start procedures in advance
- 3. Enough resources for the controls
  - ► Extra manpower
  - ► Or risk analysis



## **How Cheaper CUSTOMS procedures?**



- 1. Harmonization
- 2. Simplified procedures
- 3. Re use of data
- **4. Adapted controls** (non-intrusive, inland)



## How more predictable CUSTOMS procedures?





- Rulings (HS code, Value)
- Monitoring
- AEO
