Note by the secretariat

- 1. The secretariat of the Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA) has prepared the proposed organization of work for the twelfth session of the Committee on Water Resources in order to facilitate the consideration of agenda items within time limitations. The Committee will be presented with the proposed organization of work contained in the next section of this document and shall adopt it in that or an amended form.
- 2. The first meeting of the twelfth session will be convened at 9.30 a.m. on Wednesday, 22 March 2017. This arrangement aims to allow for parallel events, namely the Expert group meeting on methodologies for achieving the water-related SDGs at the national, regional and global levels (in two segments on 22 and 23 March 2017) and the commemoration of World Water Day (on 23 March 2017). The session will conclude at 12 p.m. on Friday, 24 March 2017.
- 3. Each presentation given by the secretariat shall be limited to 10-15 minutes and be followed by a discussion, which must not exceed 30 minutes. Should the discussion of an agenda item be concluded ahead of schedule, the next agenda item will be brought forward for discussion.
