GCM implementation, follow-up & review



- Concerted efforts at the **global, regional, national and local levels**
- Implement in cooperation and partnership with **all the relevant stakeholders**
- States are encouraged to develop, an ambitious **national responses** for the implementation
- The UN Secretary-General established a **United Nations Network on Migration**
- IOM will serve as the **coordinator and secretariat** of the UN network;
- The UN Secretary-General to **report to the General Assembly** on a biennial basis on the implementation of the GCM

The GCM follow up and review process

- Review on the progress made at the **local, national, regional and global levels** on the GCM implementation
- Through a **State-led** approach
- With the participation of **all relevant stakeholders**
- **International Migration Review Forum (IMRF)** will take place every four years beginning in 2022;
- **Regional Review** will begin in 2020, to effectively inform each edition of the IMRF



Regional level Review of the GCM

- Issue Based Coalition on Migration in the Arab Region and a Regional UN Network on Migration were established on April 2020
- Ensuring **effective, timely, coordinated UN system-wide support** to Member States in their implementation, follow-up and review of the GCM.

GCM follow-up and review in the Arab region

- Covers **22 Member States** of the League of Arab States (LAS)
- Assisted by three partner agencies **IOM, LAS and UN ESCWA** in close coordination with the Regional UN Network members

National level preparation for the Regional Review

- National UN Networks established in Bahrain, Jordan, Kuwait, Morocco, Saudi Arabia and the UAE
- Voluntary GCM Review Report submission by Member States
 - To date, received from 9 countries
 - Reports are posted at the UN Network website
- National Consultation Processes
 - through whole-of-government and whole-of-society approaches

Regional Conference and a Capacity Building Workshop

Held on December 2019 in Cairo

Two Capacity Building Workshops

Held online on June and August 2020

Regional Conference

Initially planned for December 2020/ may be postponed to Q1 of 2021

Shared with MS to guide National Voluntary Stocktaking

Multi-stakeholder online consultations

Planned for October/ November 2020

Regional Review Report
Planned for January 2020 (TBC)
