The Financial Status of the Commission's Programmes Statement on the Financial Contribution Account 1/ (Report of the Executive Secretary)

A. The Financial Status of the Commission's Programmes

- 1. In its resolution 45 (IV) the Commission requested the Executive Secretary to submit a financial report for the period between the sessions of the Commission. This report is submitted in accordance with that request. However, in view of the adoption by the United Nations of a biennial programme budget system, the information provided hereunder, for the Commission secretariat's regular budget appropriations are for the bienna 1978/79 and 1980/81. The abbreviated form of the data provided below constitutes part of the official records of the General Assembly:
 - (a) 1978/79 biennium budget: The allotments for the biennium 1978/1979 amounted to \$ 10,672,800 of which \$ 10,535,918 were expended leaving an unencumbered balance of \$ 136,882;

^{1/} Wherever this term appears in the Commission's documents it refers to the Trust Fund for ECWA Regional Activities which is the name under which the Financial Contributions Account appears in the published accounts of the United Nations.

- (b) 1980/1981 biennium budget: The sum of \$ 14,306,600 has been appropriated for the biennium 1980/1981 under Section 14 of the regular budget, and \$ 1,164,200 under Section 24 (Regular Programme of Technical Co-operation).
- 2. In addition to the expenditure for the biennium 1978/1979 in the regular budget (Section 10) specifically for the Commission, expenditure was incurred for the activities, and in the amounts (in US dollars) listed below:

B. Statement on the Financial Contributions Account

- 4. In accordance with operative para 4 of resolution 45 (IV) the following financial statements are attached:
 - (a) Combined Status of Trust Funds as at 31 December 1978 (Appendix I);
 - (b) Statement of Utilization of the Financial Contributions Account (Appendix II).
- 5. In addition to the foregoing:
 - (a) The Government of the Netherlands has offered to make \$ 200,000 available to assist in the work programme in 1980;
 - (b) The Federal Republic of Germany has expressed interest in contributing to projects included in ECWA's work programme. Negotiations are underway for the possible financing of projects in Desertification, Cartography, Trade Information and Telecommunications.

The receipt of these funds is subject to the concurrence of the United Nations Secretariat in New York. This concurrence has already been obtained in the case of the contribution of \$ 37,000.— mentioned on page 3 of this document, from the Government of France, for the services for one year at ECWA of an Assistant Statistician.
