TNTRODUCTION

This document supplements the secretariat's financial report to the Commission (E/ECWA/117). The following activities were undertaken during 1980:

- 1. Research and studies: Eight papers, resulting from research on the pattern of economic development in Arab countries, were prepared during the period under review. Also, preparations are being made to publish the main work in two volumes. In addition, 18 papers have been published by researchers and staff members of the Institute.
- 2. Short-term Courses: Courses were on the following subjects:
 - (a) A course on planning for the United Arab Emirates;
 - (b) a course on financial planning and budget preparation in the Gulf countries;
 - (c) a course on the implementation and follow-up of development plans;
 - (d) a course on project identification and preparation;
 - (e) a course on plan preparation and planning techniques.
- 3. Seminars, conferences, expert meetings:

A conference was held on new development concepts and strategies and their relevance to the Arab world. In addition, an expert group meeting on the problem of housing and human settlements was also held, and a bi-weekly seminar was arranged by the Institute during the period 14 January - 5 May 1980. Nine papers were also presented for discussion by various lecturers from the Institute and other Arab organizations in Kuwait.

A four-week training course was organised for housemothers, teachers and administrators of Beit As-Smoud. The training dealt with integrated social services, health, nutrition, child psychology, and the programming of activities for children. The course also covered general administration, planning and programming and budgeting techniques, so that the housemothers, teachers and administrators could acquire knowledge of both aspects of their work, namely child care and administration. About 30 women were trained during the course.

Follow-up activities, approved by the Consultative Committee, include the provision of a trainer for group activities for the youth and children of Beit As-Smoud. The trainer began his assignment on 1 September 1979, and it will end on 30 August 1981.

In addition, funds were used to provide equipment for setting up three handicraft workshops, for metal work, woodwork, and basic electricity. The purpose of these workshops is to introduce the young men of Beit As-Smoud - and the girls, in part - to vocational education and to begin self-reliance maintenance activities for Beit As-Smoud. The assistance will end by 30 September 1981.
