REQUEST FROM THE PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE WORK OF THE SESSION IN THE CAPACITY OF OBSERVER

Note from the Secretariat

The Secretariat of the Economic Commission for Mestern Asia has received a note from the Political Department of the Polestine Liberation Organization expressing its desire to participate in the meetings of the Second Session of the Commission in its capacity of observer to the United Nations.

We reproduce below the paragraphs of resolution 3237 (XXIX) of the General Assembly of the United Nations which relate to the accordance of observer status to the Palestine Liberation Organization.

- 11. Invites the Palestine Liberation Organization to participate in the sessions and the work of the General Assembly in the capacity of observer;
- 2. Invites the Palestine Liberation Organization to participate in the sessions and the work of all international conferences convened under the auspices of the General Assembly in the capacity of observer;
- 3. Considers that the Palestine Liberation Organization is entitled to participate as an observer in the sessions and work of all international conferences convened under the auspices of other organs of the United Nations;
- 4. Requests the Secretary-General to take the necessary steps for the implementation of the present resolution.
