I. RESOLUTION 5(I). PREPARATION FOR THE FOURTH CONFERENCE OF UNIDO

1. The first session of the Standing Committee for the Programme requested the Executive Secretary of ECWA to undertake the necessary co-ordination with the concerned Arab organizations and federations, particularly the Arab Industrial Development Organization (AIDO) with a view to reaching a joint position for UNIDO IV.
2. Collaboration with AIDO on this matter took place within the context of the overall co-operation agreement reached between AIDO and ECWA on 25 January 1984. By virtue of this agreement a Joint Co-ordination Committee to meet periodically on formulation, co-ordination and review of progress in the implementation of AIDO/ECWA programmes was established. This Committee formulated a specific programme for co-ordination that included the preparation for UNIDO IV.
3. Thus, the ECWA secretariat participated in the meetings organized by AIDO to discuss the studies and papers which were prepared by AIDO for presentation to the Sixth Arab Industrialization Conference scheduled to be held at Damascus in May 1984. The latter meeting is expected to formulate an Arab position on the major issues and agenda items of UNIDO IV scheduled to take place at Vienna early August 1984.

II. RESOLUTION 2(I). PRIORITIES

1. This note is prepared pursuant to paragraph 1 to 3 of resolution 2(I) requesting the Executive Secretary to submit to the Standing Committee for the Programme in its second regular session a report on programme priorities, including the amalgamation of programmes where necessary and the identification of programmes which are outdated or of no benefit and further requesting a classification of programmes and programme implementation in member countries including:

- (a) A description of the programme and its objectives;
- (b) Its costs, the expected results, progress made in its implementation, and an interim projects evaluation.

A. Programme priorities

2. The question of programme priorities, referred to in paragraph 1 and 2 of resolution 2(I) can be reviewed against the existing programme structure consisting of programmes, subprogrammes and programme elements. The question of resource concentration can, therefore, also be considered at these three levels. During the biennium 1984-1985 the secretariat is committed to undertake 15 substantive programmes composed of 31 subprogrammes and 86 programme elements. Pursuant to the observations of the Committee, the secretariat is recommended that resources should be concentrated to a greater extent on programme priorities with a view to maximizing outputs.

1. Concentration of resources at the programme level

3. Since the secretariat has already been committed to undertaking activities under 15 programmes during the biennium 1984-1985, concentration of resources involving amalgamation and/or elimination termination of low-priority programmes is not possible. Following the adoption of the first-level priority areas by the Ad Hoc Intergovernmental Expert Committee which met in April 1982 and which were subsequently endorsed by the ninth session of the Commission, the secretariat took various steps to concentrate its programme resources to a greater extent on the following selected programme priorities:

- (a) Industrialization
- (b) Food security
- (c) Rural development

(d) Science and technology;

(e) Human resources development;

(f) Development strategies including the least developed countries;

(g) Data development;

(h) Energy.

4. Increased resource allocations to the above programme priorities have been effected within the context of the 1984-1985 programme of work and priorities now approved by the General Assembly. The increased resource allocation for expanded activities has been made possible through (a) internal redeployment of resources from low-priority programmes, and (b) additional resources approved by the General Assembly. The following paragraphs indicate the extent of additional resource allocations and their deployment.

(a) Industrialization*

5. This programme priority was strengthened through additional resources (one P-4 post) approved by the General Assembly for expanding the Commission's work in the area of capital goods industries. In addition, the secretariat has allocated extra-budgetary resources made available by donor countries for various activities under this priority area (i.e. capital goods, micro-electronics).

(b) Food security

6. Activities pertaining to the promotion of food security are undertaken within the context of the food and agriculture programme through a subprogramme. A limited strengthening of the food security activities has been effected through internal redeployment from another subprogramme (see annex I, p.1).

(c) Rural development

7. Activities pertaining to the promotion of rural development are carried out within the context of the food and agriculture programme through a subprogramme, as well as under the social

development programme through a specific programme element. Activities pertaining to rural development will only be marginally strengthened through allocation of extrabudgetary resources.

(d) Science and technology

8. Activities pertaining to the cross-sectoral development and application of science and technology, mainly carried out under the science and technology programme, will be strengthened during the biennium through additional resources (one P-4 post) made available through redeployment from a low-priority programme.

(e) Human resources development

9. Activities pertaining to human resources development are carried out primarily under the population and social development programmes. During the biennium 1984-1985 activities under both programmes will be strengthened through (a) additional resources approved by the General Assembly (one P-4 and one local-level post) for strengthening of demographic studies under the population programme; (b) the redeployment of the resources available under the labour, management and employment programme to the population programme so as to increase effectiveness of the limited resources allocated to that programme for the biennium 1982-1983; (c) redeployment of resources at the request of the General Assembly to integrate into the regular budget a senior women's officer post previously funded by the Voluntary Fund for the United Nations Decade for Women, to manage technical assistance projects financed by the Fund during 1984-1985.

(f) Development strategies including least-developed countries

10. Programme activities related to development strategies are mainly carried out under the programme of development issues. Work related to development of least-developed countries is specifically carried out within the context of a subprogramme in the programme of development issues. All programmes, however, include work pertaining to the two least-developed countries, Democratic Yemen and Yemen. Annex I to this report reflects the secretariat's emphasis in this regard.

(g) Data development

11. The development of data, information and statistics is pursued by the secretariat under all programmes but more specifically under the programmes of Statistics, and Administration

and Common Services. As compared to the previous biennium, data development will be strengthened during 1984-1985 in the following manner:

(a) Strengthening of the statistics programme through internal redeployment of resources (one P-4 post and two local-level posts) so as to centralize statistical data-gathering under the statistics programme;

(b) Computerization of statistical activities made possible through the acquisition of a computer installation;

(c) The installation of an alternate voice and data-based communication line circuit enabling the secretariat to access data information systems in New York and Geneva;

(d) The allocation of extrabudgetary resources for the development of information-retrieval systems within the context of a proposed Arab Regional Documentation Centre for Economic and Social Development for which the secretariat is exerting efforts to mobilize resources.

(h) Energy

12. With effect from 1 January 1984 a new energy programme has been established through redeployment of resources from the natural resources programme. As compared with the 1982-1983 biennium, the resources available for energy development during the 1984-1985 biennium will be increased by one P-5 and one P-4 post to expand the work in new and renewable sources of energy and energy conservation. This redeployment was made possible through the termination of the entire subprogramme on minerals. In addition, the secretariat will be strengthening work in energy through extrabudgetary resources for activities in energy modelling, and development of new and renewable sources of energy (solar energy in particular).

2. Resource concentration measures during the biennium 1986-1987

13. During the second half of 1984, the secretariat will be preparing the programme budget 1986-1987 to be submitted to the Commission through the Standing Committee for the Programme at its twelfth session in April 1985. The secretariat intends to pursue the Committee's resolution on programme priorities during that biennium also. Hence, the Committee is requested to make a pronouncement on further measures for resource concentration during the 1986-1987 programme biennium. Such measures may include: (a) the reformulation of low-priority programmes as a function of high-priority programmes; (b) the amalgamation and

reformulation of related programmes; (c) further redeployments from low to high-priority programmes.

(a) Reformulation_of_programmes

14. Under this category it could be envisaged that the natural resources programme (water resources) would be formulated as a complementary programme to, for example, the high-priority programme of food and agriculture (i.e. activities dealing with agricultural water use) or industrialization (i.e. industrial water use) etc. The Committee is requested to take such a decision on the orientation of this programme in order to increase its effectiveness.

(b) Amalgamation_of_programmes

15. During the biennium 1984-1985 it could be envisaged to amalgamate the resources of the present public finance and international trade programme and formulate an international trade and development finance programme along the same pattern as existing UNCTAD programmes in this area. The secretariat is of the view that such a programme would achieve greater impact than the present dispersement of resources over too many unrelated programme elements.

(c) Further_redeployment_from_low_to_high-priority_programmes

16. The secretariat believes that further redeployment from low- to high-priority programmes could not be continued without an adverse effect on the usefulness of such low-priority programmes. The secretariat, in the interest of integrated development, has to maintain a certain minimum level of resource allocations to all existing programmes. The Committee may wish eventually, on the basis of programme evaluation, to decide on further redeployments. The secretariat further believes that greater effectiveness and impact of its programmes can be achieved by strengthening programme interrelationships.

3. Resource_concentration_at_the_subprogramme_level

17. The allocation of resources to subprogrammes emanates from the medium-term plan for the period 1984-1989. This plan constitutes the policy framework for the preparation of biennial budgets. Within the context of medium-term plan revisions, the secretariat has the opportunity to propose termination of subprogrammes. In this manner two entire subprogrammes, mineral resources and development of tourism, were terminated and resources redeployed to high-priority subprogrammes. The secre-

tariat recommends that further terminations are identified, bearing in mind the resources available for carrying out subprogramme objectives.

4. Resource concentration at the programme element level

18. The Committee at its first meeting observed that the available programme resources were perhaps dispersed over too many programme elements thus having an adverse effect on the impact and usefulness of the equally large number of outputs.

19. The secretariat having analysed the programme performance for the biennium 1982-1983 (see E/ECWA/XI/CP/5) has concluded that resource concentration on a reduced number of programme elements and outputs would be conducive to the secretariat's efforts to aim towards greater efficiency, rationalization and increased output delivery, particularly in the light of the vacancy situation within the secretariat.

20. In Annex I to this report, the secretariat has identified a number of programme elements as obsolete, ineffective or of marginal usefulness and recommends their termination. The resources to be released as a result of such termination are proposed to be redeployed to high-priority elements and their output to be expanded in scope. In this manner the number of programme elements and outputs could be reduced by approximately 25 per cent, while greater programme integration can be achieved.

21. The proposals for resource concentration at the programme element level are made within the context of the programme budget for 1984-1985. The resources authorized by the General Assembly have committed the secretariat to undertake all elements for which funds have been appropriated.

22. However, in line with resolution 36/228 bearing in mind regulation 4.3 of Article IV of the regulations governing programme planning, the Committee may recommend curtailment of termination of low-priority elements. The secretariat's proposals should therefore be considered within this context.

5. Classification of programmes

23. In connection with operative paragraph 3 of resolution 2(I) concerning the classification of programmes and programme implementation in member countries, the secretariat has prepared for consideration of the Committee annex II, to this document which classifies ECWA's programmes for the biennium 1984-1985 in terms of their descriptions, objectives, costs, the expected outputs and scope. Evaluation activities during the biennium 1984-1985

will be carried out in accordance with the principles and time-table contained in E/ECWA/XI/CP/4.

24. The medium-term plan for the period 1984-1989 is the principal policy directive of the United Nations and serves as the framework for the formulation of the biennial programme budgets within the period covered by the plan. The focus of the plan is on the subprogramme objectives and the strategies for carrying out the objectives. At its twentieth session the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination (CPC) recommended that:

The subprogramme structure within each programme should be based on its objectives and not the internal administrative structure of the Secretariat-Unit responsible for the programme....

25. Subprogramme Objectives: The set of subprogramme objectives of the medium-term plan which form the basis of the formulation of programme elements for the biennium 1984-1985 are derived directly from objectives which are explicit or implicit in the most comprehensive legislation governing the work of the programme, namely the resolutions of the General Assembly, the Economic and Social Council, the regional commissions, and the international and regional conferences. Subprogramme objectives are structured around: (a) The intergovernmental objective as expressed in the legislative mandate(s), the achievement of which usually requires action by Governments in order to help solve problems through necessary changes in their economic policies; (b) The general or time-limited objective of the secretariat is aimed at facilitating the pursuance of the intergovernmental objective. It is within the framework of the subprogramme objective that programme elements, and related costs and outputs are formulated.

* The programme structure consists of three levels:

A major programme consists of all activities in a sector both at the United Nations Secretariat and in the regional commissions;

A subprogramme within a major programme consists of all activities in the sector that are directed at the accomplishment of one medium-term plan objective;

A programme element is an activity at the project level for its equivalent. In most instances the output of a programme element is a publication, a field action or a meeting.

26. Total costs per subprogramme objective: For the biennium 1984-1985 the total cost per subprogramme objective represents the dollar value of resources required to implement the programmed activities of programme element(s) relating to one specific subprogramme objective; the only exception being the total cost of programmed activities relating to the programme of transnational corporations. The regional economic commissions perform liaison and support functions for the programme of the United Nations Centre on Transnational Corporations (UNCTC). ECWA make inputs to the three subprogrammes of UNCTC. The cost of ECWA inputs is figured for the totality of these subprogrammes and related outputs as indicated in annex II. The total costs are payments to resources categorized as follows: (a) established posts; (b) consultants; (c) ad hoc expert groups; (d) common staff costs; and (e) the official travel of staff. The distinguished delegates may wish to know that the total cost per subprogramme objective as indicated in the annex is subject to change because of alterations in the rate of inflation, changes in the availability of extrabudgetary resources and post vacancies. It is obvious that such changes will necessarily influence the implementation rate and the delivery of planned outputs.

27. Expected results: The expected results of the planned activities during the biennium 1984-1985 are outputs in various forms such as meetings, publications, ad hoc expert meetings etc. Outputs are produced in accordance with work plans and schedules. The secretariat has designed a monitoring system which records the progress made towards the implementation of planned activities and output delivery on a four-month basis.

28. Scope of activities: The scope of ECWA's planned activities covers essentially four levels: regional, subregional, intercountry and country. The delivery of outputs at these levels is scheduled throughout the biennium and it is subject to change due to unexpected forces such as unavailability of funds, post vacancies, postponement of meetings etc. It is worth mentioning the dimension of interregional joint programming which has been added to the scope of ECWA activities because of recent mandates. Under the guidance of the Standing Committee such activities will take a more definite form when the ongoing negotiations concerning mutual co-operation between ECWA and other regional commissions are concluded.
