

United Nations Economic Commission for Western Asia at COP22

The United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA), one of five Regional Commissions of the United Nations, aims to stimulate economic activity in member states, strengthen cooperation between them and promote sustainable development in the Arab region.



The ESCWA region contributes less than 5 per cent to global greenhouse gas emissions but is one of the most vulnerable to the impacts of climate change. In recent years, the region has experienced rising average temperatures, leading to hotter summers and more frequent heat waves. Reduced rainfall in coming years will further exacerbate regional water shortages. Weather patterns are becoming more unpredictable, and the region is subject to growing climate extremes including droughts and floods, shifts in seasons, and growing variability in river flows and recharge rates of groundwater aquifers.

During COP22, ESCWA has partnered with Member States as well as several regional and international organizations to organize the following side events.
