- Adopting leading edge technologies for Energy and Natural Resources saving
- Building materials that employ recyclable content and technologically developed eco-friendly systems with an emphasis on energy saving

- Featuring biking racks and preferred parking spots for hybrid and electric cars, to aid in remarkably reducing the carbon footprint within the city


























S4S Smart for Sustainability
