




Proportion of population using safely managed, basic, limited, unimproved sanitation services or practising open defecation, 2015



74 million people in the Arab Region lacked a basic sanitation service in 2015, 25 million of whom practise open defecation





Number of people without basic sanitation services in 2015 (74 million)




Number of people practising open defecation in 2015 (25 million)




Drinking water coverage

51 million people in the Arab Region lacked a basic drinking water service in 2015, 73% of whom live in rural areas




Countries in the region with the highest number of people who did not use a basic water service in 2015








Hygiene coverage

Proportion of population with basic, limited handwashing facilities or no facility in 2015









In 2015, 94% of the urban population and 77.5% of the rural population used a basic drinking water service.

In 2015, 90.2% of the urban population and 68.4% of the rural population used a basic sanitation service.


Open defecation




In 2015, 0.6% of the urban population and 14.3% of the rural population practised open defecation.

The unfinished Water, Sanitation and Hygiene Agenda

DRINKING WATER



- Extending **basic drinking water service** to 13% (51 million) in the region mainly in Sudan, Yemen, Morocco, Somalia, Iraq and Algeria.
- Accelerating and sustaining progress towards 2030 universal basic water: progress is too slow in 10 countries and basic water services are decreasing in 3 countries.
- Managing drinking water safety: 87% of the population has basic water services, but it was not possible to estimate the regional number of population served by safely managed drinking water services because estimates were available for only 7 countries.
- Reducing urban/rural inequalities: 6% of the population in urban areas versus 23% in rural areas still lacks even a **basic drinking water service**.
- Improving monitoring of drinking water quality: data were available for only 7 countries: Bahrain, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Morocco, Oman, and Tunisia.

SANITATION



- Ending **open defecation** which is still practiced by 25 million mainly in Sudan, Yemen, Somalia, Morocco, and Mauritania.
- Extending **basic sanitation services** to 19% (74 million) mainly in Sudan, Yemen, Somalia, Morocco, Egypt and Iraq.
- Improving monitoring of sanitation safety: reporting on **safely managed sanitation services** was possible in only 15 countries.
- Managing sanitation safety: of the 81% of the population using **at least basic sanitation** only 29% were served by **safely managed sanitation services**.
- Reducing urban/rural inequalities: most of people practising **open defecation** live in rural areas; 10% of the population in urban areas versus 31% of rural lack basic sanitation; most of people using **safely managed sanitation services** live in urban areas.

HYGIENE



- Improving access to hand washing facilities (with soap and water): 27% of the population (106 million) has no basic handwashing facility.
- 12% of the population (47 million) has access to a limited handwashing facility (without water or soap).
- 15% of the population (59 million) has access to no facilities.
- Coverage of basic handwashing facilities with soap and water varied from 10 to 91 per cent.
- The rural /urban inequalities are wide: 83 % of the population in urban areas versus 59 % in rural areas has access to basic handwashing facilities.
- Improving monitoring of access to basic handwashing facilities: many high income countries lacked sufficient data..
