RESOLUTION 322 (S-V) ON THE REQUEST OF MAURITANIA FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COMMISSION FOR WESTERN ASIA

The Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia,

Noting the communication of 30 April 2015 from the Minister of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation of Mauritania to the secretariat of the Commission, in which she expressed the desire of Mauritania to accede to the Commission,

Noting also the accession of the Sudan to the Commission in 2008, pursuant to Economic and Social Council resolution 2008/8 of 22 July 2008, and the accession of Libya, Morocco and Tunisia, pursuant to Economic and Social Council resolution 2012/1 of 10 July 2012,

Recalling its resolution 302 (XXVII) of 10 May 2012 inviting all Arab countries to become members of the Commission,

1. Welcomes the request of Mauritania for membership of the Commission;

2. *Recommends* that the Economic and Social Council approve the request of Mauritania;

3. *Requests* the Executive Secretary of the Commission to follow up on the implementation of the present resolution.
