# Target 12.6: Encourage companies to adopt sustainable practices and sustainability reporting

Encourage companies, especially large and transnational companies, to adopt sustainable practices and to integrate sustainability information into their reporting cycle.

Core Elements

#### Indicator 12.6.1:

Number of companies publishing sustainability reports

#### What is a <u>sustainability report</u> under this indicator?

- Corporate reporting on Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) issues (non-financial reporting)
- Methodology introduces <u>minimum reporting requirements</u> for ESG, and economic, areas.
- Other reports that include sustainability information will also be considered.

#### How do we report on the indicator?

- Reporting on global and country level.
- By company size and industry sector.

# Not a New Reporting Framework!

SDG 12.6.1 defines a common subset of reporting areas across different frameworks:



Minimum Requirements - Examples



#### **Institutional and governance:**

- Sustainability strategy
- Governance structure
- Anti-fraud/corruption

#### **Economic:**

- Direct measure of economic performance
- Indirect measure of economic performance

Minimum Requirements - Examples

#### **Environmental:**

- Energy consumption
- Water consumption
- GHG emissions
- Other emissions and effluents
- Waste generation / minimisation and recycling practices

#### Social:

- Occupational health and safety
- Number of employees
- Employee training
- Unfair/illegal labour practices
- Human rights
- Diversity


# **Promoting Ambitious Reporting**

Advanced Requirements in Methodology for 12.6.1 - Examples

- Stakeholder engagement
- Supplier sustainability engagement
- Sustainable procurement and sourcing
- Environmental performance information in terms of intensity values (e.g. consumption of energy, and water per unit of production)

Allows for tracking progress of companies moving from 'minimum' to 'advanced'

## **Data Gathering Process for 12.6.1**



## **Data Gathering Process - Pilot**

- By Data Partner Global Al
- Using AI technology
- Databases of the GRI and UN Global Compact
- Pilot: over 4,000 reports collected and analyzed
- Preliminary results:
  - 85% reporting on Minimum Requirements.
  - 40% reporting on Advanced Requirements.

## **Next Steps**

- Update of the methodology for 12.6.1 following results and learnings from pilot
  - Add to data sources, other databased, websites...
- Awareness raising at the national level:
  - How can governments encourage companies to advance sustainability reporting and report on 12.6.1?
  - Are sustainability reports being collected / how could it be organized?
